Guest Speaker

Mr. Zang discussed the scope of the 2-2-1 program that covers Licking and Knox counties. 2-1-1 is the designated dial number-program whose purpose is to provide referrals. It makes critical connections between individuals or families in need with the appropriate community based organizations and government agencies. It is a crisis hotline service and a part of the Information Center of Pathways. Typical referrals include issues of rent, food, and utilities. Additionally, domestic violence, bullying, mental health, addiction, financial and medical referrals are also common.

Treasurer's Report

The previous budget of \$3186.39 has increased by \$630.00, with revenues of \$15.00 from membership dues, \$115.00 from the yard sale, and \$500.00 from a private donation. The expenses to date are \$648.99 related to the yard sale, clean-up and the scholarship.
