### Guest Speaker

Mr. Abel stated that this is a government agency addressing household recycling with services in Coshocton, Perry, Licking and Fairfield Counties. Newark area drop-off points include 877 E. Main, Reddington Rd; Flory Park, 140 Everett Ave; and 161 Myrtle Ave. Recyclables include the following materials:

- 1) all household paper and cardboard – magazines, junk mail, catalogs, corrugated cardboard, boxes.
- 2) all household glass – not auto, plate, mirror glass
- 3) steel food cans - not random pipes, auto metal, or empty paint cans
- 4) aluminum cans – not lawn chairs, gutters, siding
- 5) household plastic – 7 types of plastics, but not buckets, PVC, toys.

Mr. Abel also said that his office can provide referrals and assist in private community recycling efforts, which may include other materials, such as tires and metals.
